Bob has performed with the San Jose, Oakland, Napa, Monterey and Berkeley symphonies and currently plays with the Menlo and Oxford Brass Quintets. He was a member of the SF 49's band and toured with the Colombia Artists Bel Canto Brass. He has also performed at the San Francisco and Frankfurt Jazz festivals as well as at the Filmfare Awards in Mumbai India. Bob was also a member of Tom Petty's high school rock band – after Tom left the group. Bob also is a published composer and arranger for string orchestra.
